

#### **Services**

Webster Street Academy is based on a model of community partnership. We are not a charter school or a public school. Students remain actively enrolled in their home school but are referred to Webster Street Academy when it becomes clear they need more.

#### **Therapeutic Intervention**

Students referred to Webster Street receive a diagnostic assessment from a therapist. Then, we figure out the areas the student is struggling in and what intervention we can put in place to assist. Students participate in daily group therapy and individual weekly therapy sessions led by licensed counselors and social workers.

#### **Educational Programming**

Webster Street Academy's educational curriculum is aligned with the Ohio Department of Education. Students utilize a self-paced approach focused on the core areas of English, math, social studies, science and various electives.

This therapeutic piece is what sets Webster Street Academy apart. When it's wrapped around an engaging educational program our students have the best chance for success. State licensed teachers and behavioral aides work alongside our therapists and case workers to ensure close, personal relationships develop with our students. In this setting kids are both academically successful and learn the coping skills they need to help get them back on track.
